The Big Lottery: Reaching Out - Connecting Older People Programme: Funding for 3 to 5 year programmes

- Minimum grant of 50k – 200k.
- Maximum grant 250k – 500k
- To target older people at risk of exclusion and isolation
- To assist older people lead fuller more connected lives as valued members of their community.
- Potential bidders must involve older people in design, development & delivery of their project.



Who is ABC Seniors Network?

We are an older people's network lead by older volunteers working in the Armagh, Banbridge and Craigavon council areas.
